## **TheraSuit Parent Summary**

Below is the list of steps required for your child to participate in this program:

- 1. Please complete the medical form thoroughly and return to us by email, mail or fax as soon as possible. We cannot proceed without receiving this completed form.
- 2. After the completed medical form is received in our office, Zoe Planck (our director), will review the information to make a preliminary decision as to whether your child is a good candidate for the Therasuit Method®. Our office manager, Haylee Carey, will then contact you by phone to follow up and let you know the outcome.
- 3. If it is determined that your child is a candidate, you will receive a call from our office manager to set up an initial 1-hour assessment in our clinic. The fee for this assessment is \$170, due at the time of the appointment. If your child is approved to start the program after the initial session, the \$170 will be applied to the deposit required to hold your child's spot on the schedule.
- 4. If your child is cleared to participate in the program, there is a \$1,000 non-refundable deposit required to hold your child's spot on the schedule. Our office manager will speak with you before you leave the initial appointment about the fees and schedule openings. Please understand that the \$1,000 deposit is required **before** we can put your child on the schedule.
- 5. The remaining balance is required to be paid 1 week prior to the scheduled session start date.
- 6. Please be on time for all scheduled Therasuit Method® appointments. Please bring healthy snacks (such as yogurt, nuts, cheese sticks etc.) and beverages (water, 100% coconut water, etc.) for your child each day as the TheraSuit Method® is intensive and your child will require extra rest, nutrition and hydration during his/her 3 -4 week block. Please dress your child in comfortable clothing. Cotton pants are best.
- 7. If your child currently receives Speech and/or Occupational Therapy in our office on a weekly basis, those appointments will be put on hold until the end of the three week TheraSuit session due to the intensity of the TheraSuit Method®.
- 8. Parents and/or caregivers are welcome to stay with the child throughout the session unless the therapist determines it is a distraction for the child.
